QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS: Various gardening jobs require varied levels of physical fitness but anyone is welcome to participate and we can always find a task suitable to a volunteer's needs and desires.

TRAINING: Training is provided on site. A general orientation to the garden and its mission will be provided.

COMMENTS: We encourage volunteers to wear sturdy footwear and bring their own gloves, water and sunscreen.
