Now Open Seven Days

San Luis Obispo, CA: For over 22 years, the San Luis Obispo Botanical Garden has honored and preserved our connection with nature. Starting Saturday, March 10th, for the first time in its history, the garden will do so everyday of the week.

The display and educational gardens remain open free to the public from sunrise to sunset as it has for more than a decade. But beginning March 10, guests will be able to purchase gifts, plants and tickets to upcoming events at Eve's Gift & Garden Shop and peruse the Oak Glen Pavilion from 9 AM-5 PM every Saturday and Sunday. All of the Garden's facilities will now be open seven days a week, so weekend visitors will finally be able to access everything the Garden has to offer.

The San Luis Obispo Botanical Garden is located on 150 acres in El Chorro Regional Park off Highway One between Morro Bay and San Luis Obispo, at 3450 Dairy Creek Rd. When the master plan is complete, it will be the only botanical garden in the world exclusively devoted to the plants and ecosystems of the five mediterranean climate regions.
