



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY:

Children's Outreach



LOCATION: San Luis Obispo Botanical Garden, off Highway 1 in El Chorro Regional Park, between San Luis Obispo and Morro Bay, and other locals throughout the county as needed.

NEED: Volunteers to help us reach out to the children in our community and cure “nature deficiency.”

JOB DESCRIPTION: Volunteers will help plan and execute small, mobile activities for children that engage them with plants, planting, art in nature, animals, environment, etc. At events volunteers will talk about the children and family education events that are happening at the Garden while collecting parent information and email addresses, and handing out flyers. Hours vary.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan and participate in children's activities that are low cost and environmentally friendly
- Bring and set up tables, shade structure, and a display of Garden promotional material
- Guide children through activities throughout the event
- Talk with parents about activities happening at the Garden, collecting parent information and email addresses
- Network with other groups and hand out business cards
- Pack up, clean up and return supplies to the Garden

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be good at interacting with children
- Must be friendly and able to engage people in a crowd
- Must have knowledge of events happening at the Garden
- Must pass background check

TRAINING: Shadowing of Education Coordinator, overview of gardening tips and tricks for working with children. A general orientation to the garden and its mission will be provided.
