



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY:

Children's Program Development



LOCATION: San Luis Obispo Botanical Garden, off Highway 1 in El Chorro Regional Park, between San Luis Obispo and Morro Bay.

NEED: Volunteers to assist with the development and implementation of educational programs at the Garden for children of all age.

JOB DESCRIPTION: Children's Program Development volunteers are the key volunteers for the monthly Saturday at the Children's Garden educational outreach program to the community. Volunteers work together to develop hands-on classes on a broad range of topics, distributing flyers, and prepare for classes, including set-up and clean-up. Hours vary and are flexible, but include the second Saturday of each month and monthly team meetings.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in the development of interactive and educational classes for children ages 3 to 12 years
- Distribute press releases and flyers for classes to local schools and children's programs
- Assist with set-up, implementation, and clean-up Saturday at the Children's Garden classes

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Interested in educational outreach to children
- Good at interacting with children
- Creative and able to see a project through to completion
- Reliable and timely
- Background check may be required

TRAINING: New volunteers will be working alongside experienced volunteers and staff. A general orientation to the garden and its mission will be provided.

COMMENTS: Educational outreach to children is one of the most important aspects of the SLOBG mission of connecting people with plants, as well as a starting point for introducing more people to the long-term plans associated with the Garden.
