LOCATION: San Luis Obispo Botanical Garden, off Highway 1 in El Chorro Regional Park, between San Luis Obispo and Morro Bay.

NEED: Volunteers needed to develop and provide educational material to other volunteers and the public.

JOB DESCRIPTION: Interpretation volunteers are the educational link between the Garden and our visitors from the self-guided maps and plant labels to interpretive signage and online materials. Hours vary.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

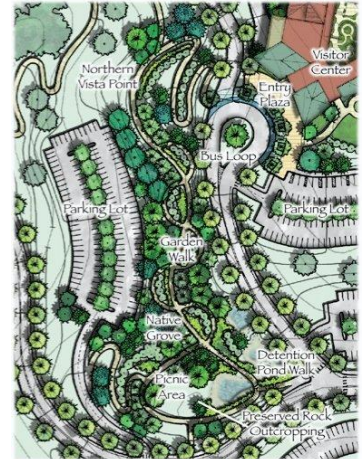
- Order and install plant labels
- Develop and print plant information sheets for use at plant sales and in the Garden Shop
- Develop and update the Self-guided Tour brochures
- Produce interpretative signage for all areas of the Garden including the buildings
- Produce plant photographs for signage, website, etc.
- Develop and update interpretive materials for docents

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Editing and writing skills
- Computer skills including photo editing programs
- Graphic design skills a plus
- Experience with educational outreach a plus

TRAINING: Specific training will include working with experienced volunteers. A general orientation to the garden and its mission will be provided.

COMMENTS: Education of the public is a primary goal in our mission of connecting people with plants.
