Common Names: evening primrose, sundrops
Size: 8 – 12 in. high, 2 ft. wide

Common Names: dasslevygle, candy bush
Size: To 1 ft. high, 2 to 3 ft. wide

Common Names: little pickles
Size: To 2 in. high, spreading

***Pelargonium* ‘Lime’**

Common Names: lime-scented geranium
Size: Compact, 1 to 3 ft. tall and wide

***Pelargonium* ‘Nutmeg’**

Common Names: nutmeg-scented geranium
Size: 1 ft. high, 2 ft. wide.
